

Project MIMIC Contingency Management Rating Parameters

Contingency Management Specific Skills

- 1. To what extent did the counselor discuss **how many prize draws were earned at this session**?
 - Clearly explain the number of prize draws earned over the prior week, including:
 - o Recap of the attendance target over the prior week
 - o Indication of whether or not the patient met the attendance target
 - o Feedback on number of prize draws earned relative to prior sessions
 - Provide a statement of support and encouragement for attending treatment
- 2. To what extent did the counselor discuss how many prize draws would be possible at the next CM session, if the patient meets the agreed-upon attendance target?
 - Clearly explain the number of prize draws that can be earned the following week, including:
 - o Definition of the attendance target the following week
 - o Explanation of what the patient needs to do to meet the attendance target
 - o Feedback on number of possible prize draws, relative to number earned in current session
 - Answer any questions patients may have regarding reinforcement at the next session.
 - Demonstrate enthusiasm and support for reinforcement
 - Optional (but encouraged): Provide a written slip documenting the number of draws
- 3. How well did the counselor **administer reinforcement**?
 - Award the correct number of draws
 - Award reinforcement enthusiastically
 - Ask/acknowledge the draws being placed back in the bowl
- 4. To what extent did the counselor assess patient's desire for prizes?
 - Show prize items via cabinet, menu, or handout
 - Actively assess which prize item the patient would like to pick
 - Actively assess desire for other items in the cabinet
 - Solicit ideas for new prizes
 - Express enthusiasm over prize selections
- 5. To what extent did the counselor <u>compliment or praise the patient's efforts toward meeting the attendance target</u>?
 - Praise the patient's efforts towards meeting the attendance target
 - Convey a stance of genuine caring about whether the patient attends treatment
- 6. To what extent did the counselor tie attendance and the CM program to abstinence and other treatment goals?
 - Explicitly tie attendance and the prizes patients are receiving to abstinence and broader goals.
 - Clearly explain how attendance can support abstinence
 - Give clear examples of the patient's treatment goals



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General Clinical Skills

- 7. **General skillfulness/effectiveness** (demonstrates expertise, skill and commitment, engages patient in discussion, interventions made at appropriate times—not missed or made too early).
- 8. **Maintaining session structure** (maintains session focus, sets appropriate tone and structure, appropriate level of counselor activity/directiveness, appropriate duration).
- 9. **Empathy** (conveys warmth and sensitivity, demonstrates genuine concern and a non-judgmental stance, understands and expresses clients' feelings and concerns).

CM Rating Scale Scoring (1-7)

1 = Very Poor

The therapist's skill was non-evident (item not addressed) or unacceptable, incompatible with the CM approach, and potentially counterproductive or toxic.

2 = Poor

The therapist addressed the issue, but in a poor or cursory manner; the therapist showed a lack of competence, a failure to understand the issue or its context, or lack of expertise.

3= Barely Acceptable

The therapist handled the issue in a manner somewhat consistent with the CM approach.

4 = Adequate

The therapist handled the issue in an acceptable way, consistent with CM, in an average manner.

5 = Good

The therapist addressed the issue in a manner somewhat better than average.

6 = Very Good

The therapist's skill and expertise were very evident in delivering this intervention.

7 = Excellent

The therapist demonstrated exceptional mastery and excellence in delivering the intervention.
